Be able to support the evaluation of learning activities

As a trainee practitioner, you may feel that it isn't your place to make suggestions to the class teacher on the effectiveness of the learning activities you've supported. However, it's a very important part of your job to support the evaluation of learning activities and knowing how to make your contribution appropriately and respectfully is an essential skill for you to learn.

If you understand why evaluation's important, you'll find it easier to support the process. Therefore, this lesson will help you to understand the value of evaluating learning activities and how you can provide respectful, constructive feedback on learning activities – in discussion with the teacher.

It'll be appropriate for you to identify any difficulties you encountered in supporting the learning activities, providing the teacher with feedback from your observations on how you feel the learners participated, and what progress you felt they made during the session.
